

Location: All shows at the Masonic Lodge, 10 North Street, Kennebunkport

Drop off: Thursday, 10 - 11:30 AM. Drop offs are not allowed prior to 10 AM because the workers are busy setting up prior to that time.

Pick up: Sunday, 4:15 PM. No work shall be removed from the show before 4:15 PM Sunday.

The drop off and pickup times/dates are firm. If they don't fit your schedule, make arrangements with a member who is available at these times/dates to pick up for you.

Requirements: Original work, completed within the last two years, not shown at any other MWA show. No wet paintings accepted. ALL artwork exhibited must be for sale. 3D artists must provide display pedestal(s).

Number of hanging/3D pieces allowed: Up to two pieces that fit within a 30"x30" space. For example, two 14x30, or two 12x24 (note: these are maximum outside dimensions of frames). Two 16 x 20, maximum outside dimensions of frames, are allowed. We cannot accommodate any piece greater than 30" wide because of the rack width.

Framing: Well-framed, and matted where applicable. If not framed, properly finished/painted on the edges. Must be sturdily wired and ready for hanging. No saw-tooth hangers.

Show Labels: Please send Name, Title, Medium and Price of each piece to Doris Porell within two weeks of the show. Email: d.porell51@gmail.com

Backups: 2 backups. May be art that has been shown previously in MWA shows. Box them with large label of your name on the box.

Sign up for show shifts: All participating members are expected to assist in the show process by sitting, or working on one of the committees; e.g. set-up, takedown, publicity, crafts. Contact Mary Elizabeth Grady at meliz913@gmail.com. A \$25 penalty will be assessed to members who fail to work their scheduled shift (for each shift missed).

Commission: MWA takes 15% commission. A 5.5% sales tax is added at the time of purchase.
